Services

Resettlement and Placement Program

CWS Winchester's Refugee Services programs provide up to 5 years of support for new neighbors. Through our Reception & Placement program, the CWS resettlement team provides initial welcome and core services to new neighbors within the first 90 days after arrival, empowering them towards self-sufficiency.

Preferred Communities

Provide regular and intensive case management to help client attain self-sufficiency. Provision of short-term continuum of care through culturally and linguistically appropriate referral and case management services to ORR-eligible individuals.

Legal Immigration Service

Services include Residency Applications, Asylum Applications, Work Authorizations, Citizenship Applications, Family Petition, Fee Waivers, Cuban Adjustment, TPS Applications.
