Services

Resettlement and Placement Program

CWS Wilmington resettles refugees through the US Refugee Admission Program. In its first year, CWS Wilmington resettled 109 refugees and provided services for over 50 Ukrainians.

Matching Grant Program

Provides employment services to refugees, asylees, Ukrainians, Afghans, Cuban Haitian Entrants, and Special Immigrant Visa holders.

Preferred Communities

Provides regular and intensive case management to help clients attain self-sufficiency. Provision of short-term continuum of care through culturally and linguistically appropriate referral and case management services to ORR-eligible individuals, including Ukrainians who have been granted temporary permission to shelter in the US after the Russian invasion.
