Services

Refugee Resettlement Program

CWS NorCal, alongside community co-sponsors, manages the arrival and integration of refugees being resettled through the Department of State and the Bureau of Population, Refugees, and Migration.

Anti-Human Trafficking Program

Intensive case management to adult survivors of human trafficking to help support their self-sufficiency. Community training and resources for community groups to identify and respond to trafficking situations.

Humanitarian Parolee Support

Regular and intensive case management to help clients attain self-sufficiency. Short-term continuum of care through culturally and linguistically appropriate referrals and case management services to ORR-eligible Afghans and Ukrainians.

Legal Immigration Service

Services for recently arrived Afghans and Ukrainians including Residency Applications, Asylum Applications, Work Authorizations, Citizenship Applications, Family Petitions, Fee Waivers, TPS Applications, and Re-parole.

Home Study and Post Release Services

Case Managers work with families and sponsors to promote the safety and well-being of Unaccompanied Children. By conducting in-home and virtual visits they are able to Identify safe placements for reunification. Case managers aim to connect children and sponsors to their local community through Post Release Services (PRS)
