CWS opened an office in Jersey City in 2015 as a refugee resettlement site to serve northern New Jersey. We offer comprehensive case management to over 5000 clients a year, including refugees, asylees, asylum seekers, Cuban and Haitian entrants, Unaccompanied Children, Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees, and Afghan Humanitarian Parolees.

Services

Resettlement and Placement Program

CWS Jersey City's R&P Program provides welcome and case management for newly arrived refugees from around the globe. Services include housing resources, donations of household essentials, employment assistance, and adult and youth education programs. Some families in the R&P program benefit from the involvement of Community Co-Sponsors, community groups who come together to provide some of those essential services.

Home Study and Post Release Services

HSPRS promote the safety and well-being of Unaccompanied Children by identifying safe placements for reunification with a sponsor and by connecting children and sponsors to community resources in Post Release Services. Caseworkers work with children and sponsors to set goals and action plans

Refugee Cash Assistance

RCA provides essential monetary assistance to a wide group of humanitarian migrant populations in their first year of resettlement, including victims of human trafficking, Special Immigrant Visa holders, asylees, parolees, and more.

Legal Immigration Services

These services include Residency Applications, Asylum Applications, Work Authorizations, Citizenship Applications, Family Petitions, Fee Waivers, Cuban Adjustment, and TPS Applications.

Preferred Communities

These programs provide extended, intensive case management to help clients with complex, urgent needs. These programs serve some of our most vulnerable community members to overcome diverse barriers to self-sufficiency.
