## Community Programs

### Case Management

Whether the Reception and Placement program, which begins at the airport until day 90, the Matching Grant program that offers employment focused support for 8 months, or the Preferred Communities program for our most vulnerable populations, case management provides tailored core services to help our new neighbors get set up for success.

### Employment and Social Services

Barriers to long-term self sufficiency and success are addressed by programs including Good Job Happy Families, Refugee Social Services, Employment and Employer Engagement programs and English language classes.

### Community Engagement

Co-Sponsorship is a partnership between a group of friends and our team, walking alongside our newest refugee arrivals for the first 3 months after arrival. CWS Marketplace is a refugee womens' economic empowerment program. Welcome Wagon provides a great volunteering opportunity for groups to volunteer together for a one time service project to support refugees whilst team building and learning.
