Welcoming New Neighbors

Around the world, 37 million people are displaced as refugees and asylum-seekers who flee their homes because of conflict, violence, and persecution. For the most vulnerable of these individuals and families, resettlement to a new home like the U.S. is their best hope for finding safety and building a future for themselves and their children.

Some arrive at the U.S. border to seek safety as an Asylum Seeker. Others petition for resettlement as a refugee from a host country or refugee camp. In partnership with local communities, CWS ensures that these individuals and families are met with a warm welcome and provided with the services they need to rebuild their lives in the U.S.

- ⊕ Resettlement Case Management**
Housing support, cultural orientation, healthcare access, and basic needs assistance.
- ⊕ Employment Services**
English language class, employer connections, application assistance, and interview prep.
- ⊕ Immigration Legal Services**
Free and low-cost legal services for permanent residency, citizenship, and family reunification.
