CRIS' mission is to help refugees and immigrants in Central Ohio reach safety and security, sustain self-sufficiency, and achieve successful integration into the community. In addition to refugee resettlement, CRIS offers immigration legal services, assistance for victims of crime (VOCA), family and parenting support, employment counseling and English language instruction, youth mentorship, older refugee support services, and more.
