Participants will embark on a journey of personal and professional growth, deepening their leadership ability, strengthening their sense of community and renewing their call to purpose.

What to Expect: A Journey of Transformation

A Deep Sense of Community:

Participants will address the isolation often felt in supervisory roles by building a trusted network of peers who understand their unique challenges.

Personal and Professional Growth:

Through group and one-on-one coaching, participants will strengthen skills in areas like conflict resolution, work-life balance and coaching those they supervise.

Participants will reconnect with their call to supervisory ministry, gain clarity about their next steps and feel more hopeful and empowered in their roles.
